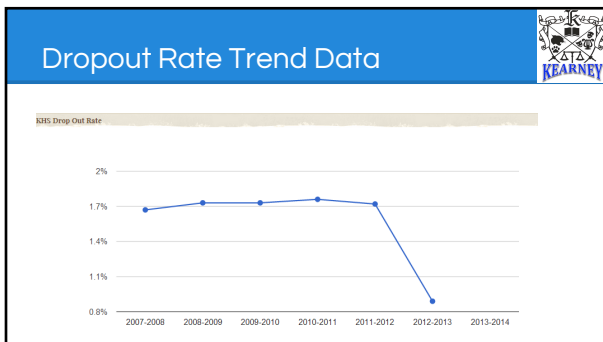
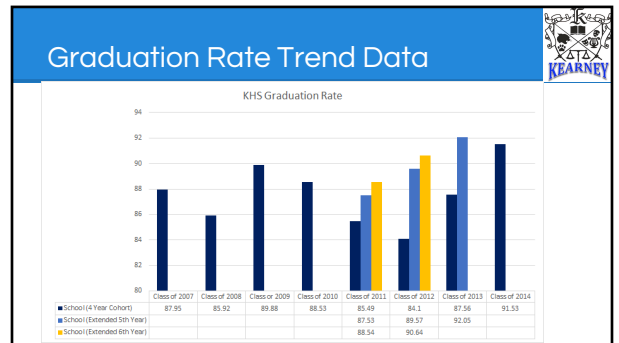

Current Research

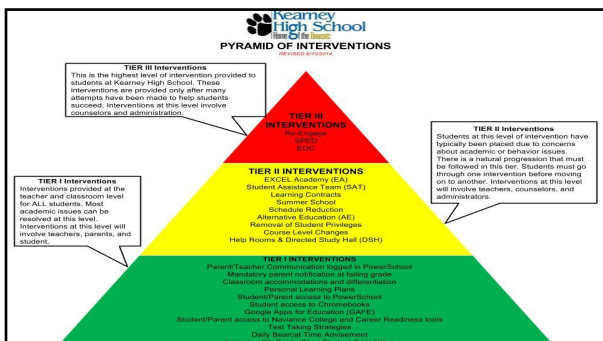
When students don't learn the first time around, every school needs to have a hierarchy of academic interventions planned and ready to go.

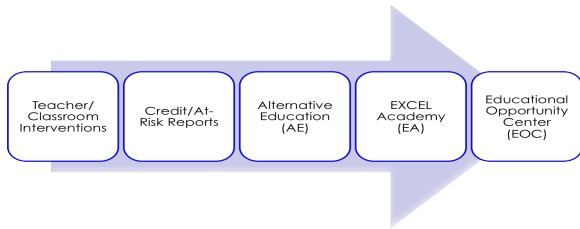
