

- Neb. Const. art. VII, § 1. Free instruction in the common schools of all persons (between the ages of 5 and 21 years.)
- AG: must provide all things necessary for instruction, such as lab equipment, textbooks, etc., w/out charge
- Student Fee Act (SFA)(§79-2,125 to §79-2,135)



- **Can** charge fee for specialized equipment/attire for:
 - (1) Participation in extracurricular activities;
 - (2) Fees and transportation for spectators attending extracurricular activities;
 - (3) Postsecondary education costs;
 - (4) Transportation per state law;
 - (5) Copies of student files or records



Student Fee Rules - (6) Reimbursement to SD/ESU for lost or damaged by the student;

- (7) Before/after-school or pre-K services
- (8) Summer school or night school;
- (9) Parking; and
 (10) Breakfast and lunch programs

Student Fee Rules

• Can require students to furnish minor personal or minor consumable items for participation in extracurricular activities



• Can require students to furnish and wear nonspecialized attire meeting general written guidelines for specified courses and activities if the written guidelines are reasonably related to the course or activity



Student Fee Rules



- Can require students to furnish musical instruments:
 - for participation in optional music courses that are not extracurricular activities
 - if school provides for free & reduced price lunch students
- No particular type
- May charge feés for equip/attire for musical extracurricular activities

Student Fee Rules

• Can have a school store for purchase of food, beverages, and personal or consumable items. It need not have a permanent physical presence; it may consist of providing order forms for students to voluntarily purchase items from the school or another vendor.



- Fee waivers/policy for:

 Participation in extracurricular activities;
 - Musical instruments


- Board members shall not receive a

- Allowable Mileage \$.575 per mile








Misc. Expenditure Rules

• SB may make expenditures for supplies, equipment, travel, meals, and lodging for school programs and activities, including extracurricular and interscholastic activities, appropriate for the benefit, government, and health of pupils enrolled in the school district.*





Misc. Expenditure Rules

 Payments to EEs for LTD coverage is for a fringe benefit, and should not be included in compensation reported to NPERS. It results in overstated benefit calculations and over payments by the EE and ER.*
