

Not Changing:


- Scoring scale of 1 to 36
- Format of assessing achievement in English, Math, Reading, and Science, with an optional essay.

ACT Changes




- Scoring 1-36, with two new sub-scores
- Subtle question changes
- Essay changes
- Career Readiness Indicator
- Computer Testing

SAT Changes

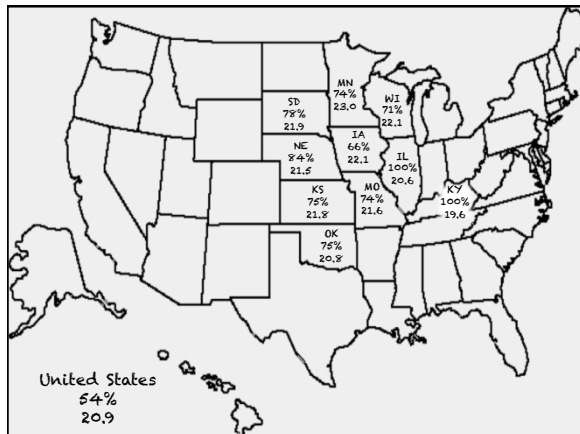


- Essay – optional
- Eliminating grammar
- Maximum Score 1600, shorter
- Reading and Math Sections will be more closely aligned with College Readiness

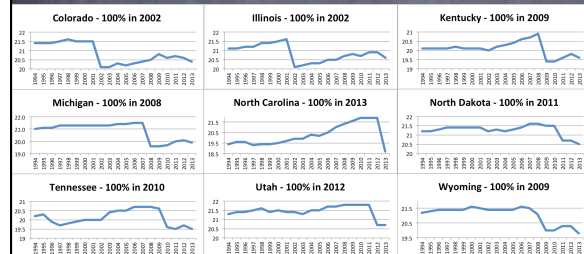
The ACT vs. the SAT



- ACT Science Section
- 14 states mandate the ACT, 1 state mandates the SAT

Three Outcomes:

1. No college degree
2. College degree with excessive debt
3. College degree with minimal debt
